4 Things God Sees in Every One of Us.

1. God sees what others miss.

Luke 1:26-28 ²⁶ In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a village in Galilee,

²⁷ to a virgin named Mary. She was engaged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of King David.

²⁸ Gabriel appeared to her and said, "Greetings, favored woman! The Lord is with you!" (NLT)

Luke 1:29-30 ²⁹ Confused and disturbed, Mary tried to think what the angel could mean.

³⁰ "Don't be afraid, Mary," the angel told her, "for you have found favor with God! (NLT)

Psalms 139:1-2 ¹ O Lord, you have examined my heart and know everything about me.

² You know when I sit down or stand up. You know my thoughts even when I'm far away. (NLT)

2. God sees your fear and faith.

Luke 1:31-35 ³¹ Listen! You will become pregnant and have a baby boy. You will name him Jesus.

³² He will be great. People will call him the Son of the Most High God, and the Lord God will make him king like his ancestor David.

³³ He will rule over the people of Jacob forever; his kingdom will never end.”

³⁴ Mary said to the angel, “How will this happen? I am still a virgin.”

³⁵ The angel said to Mary, “The Holy Spirit will come to you, and the power of the Most High God will cover you. The baby will be holy and will be called the Son of God. (ERV)

Luke 1:38 Mary responded, “I am the Lord’s servant. May everything you have said about me come true.” And then the angel left her. (NLT)

Isaiah 41:10 Don’t be afraid, for I am with you. Don’t be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand. (NLT)

3. God sees your potential.

Luke 1:30-31 ³⁰ “Don’t be afraid, Mary,” the angel told her, “for you have found favor with God!

³¹ You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus. (NLT)

Jeremiah 29:11 “‘For I know the plans I have for you,’ says the Lord. ‘They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.’” (NLT)
