5 Ways Everyone’s Heaven Will be Different

1. Believers will be rewarded differently.

2 Corinthians 5:10 For we must all stand before Christ to be judged. We will each receive whatever we deserve for the good or evil we have done in this earthly body. (NLT)

Revelation 22:12 Look, I am coming soon, bringing my reward with me to repay all people according to their deeds. (NLT)

Matthew 10:42 And if you give even a cup of cold water to one of the least of my followers, you will surely be rewarded. (NLT)

2. Believers will receive different expressions of approval from the Lord.

Matthew 25:21 The master was full of praise. "Well done, my good and faithful servant. You have been faithful in handling this

small amount, so now I will give you many more responsibilities. Let's celebrate together!" (NLT)

1 Corinthians 4:2 Now, a person who is put in charge as a manager must be faithful. (NLT)

3. Believers will have different amounts of eternal treasure.

1 Corinthians 3:11-15 ¹¹ For no one can lay any foundation other than the one we already have—Jesus Christ.

¹² Anyone who builds on that foundation may use a variety of materials - gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw.

¹³ But on the judgment day, fire will reveal what kind of work each builder has done. The fire will show if a person's work has any value.

¹⁴ If the work survives, that builder will receive a reward.

¹⁵ But if the work is burned up, the builder will suffer great loss. The builder will be saved, but like someone barely escaping through a wall of flames. (NLT)

Matthew 6:19-20 ¹⁹ Don't store up treasures here on earth, where moths eat them and rust destroys them, and where thieves break in and steal.

²⁰ Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. (NLT)

4. Believers will receive different rewards for things that nobody else may have noticed.

Colossians 3:23-24 ²³ Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people.

²⁴ Remember that the Lord will give you an inheritance as your reward, and that the Master you are serving is Christ. (NLT)

Hebrews 6:10 For God is not unjust. He will not forget how hard you have worked for him and how you have shown your love to him by caring for other believers... (NLT)

5. Believers will receive different rewards based on the people they influenced for Christ.

1 Thessalonians 2:19-20 ¹⁹ After all, what gives us hope and joy, and what will be our proud reward and crown as we stand before our Lord Jesus when he returns?

²⁰ It is you! Yes, you are our pride and joy. (NLT)

Daniel 12:3 Those who are wise will shine as bright as the sky, and those who lead many to righteousness will shine like the stars forever. (NLT)

6. Every believer will receive the greatest reward of all.

Revelation 21:3-4 ³ Look, God's home is now among his people! He will live with them, and they will be his people.

⁴ God's home is now among his people! He will live with them, and they will be his people. He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. (NLT)

1 Corinthians 2:9 No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love him.” (NLT)
